Course fees

The Fontys Summer School offers you two full weeks of daily classes and workshops (50 contact hours plus 30 hours preparation, selfstudy and (final) assignments). The fee includes lunch, coffee/tea during classdays and studymaterials.

Fontys can arrange accommodation for its Summer School students in Eindhoven. Indication of the price per night pro person € 26,00 (dorm in hostel) - € 37,00 (private room in The Student Hotel). Other expenses: e.g. excursions, transport costs, food, personal expenses to amount to approximately € 350,00. Visa expenses: These costs vary depending on your country of origin.

There are no admission requirements besides to have interest in broadening your knowledge and skills. The program is suitable for every bachelor student. Of course you need to be proficient in English.

**Programs in brief**

We offer you 3 programs during this Fontys Summer School: Experience It: Coaching for success, Self-Management of Health and Design and manufacturing of Orthopedic and Assistive devices.

Experience It: Coaching for Success

The main goal of *Experience It: Coaching for Success* is to provide you with a rich experience in coaching and success. It is about your personal development, your talents, setting goals, making your own choices, and doing what you want and what makes you happy! You will learn lots about behavior, coaching and health. We will also work on your self-confidence, where the aim is to have you experience success in many fields. Applied psychology theory will be offered in an integrated way (integrated into coaching practice). After the summer school, you will have received a lasting impulse in your development, which you take with you to utilize your own degree study.

Self-Management of Health

The main goal of *Self-Management of Health* is to provide you with an intensive and interactive learning program. The program focuses on health behaviour, and how you can support people in coping with health and disease. This comprises for example the learning of coaching skills and designing a health intervention. You will learn how to strengthen resilience and self-management skills of a client. All aimed at the achievement of the health related quality of life your client wants to reach, given the personal circumstances. As an upcoming professional you will support and coach the client to clarify what he or she believes is important and necessary in accomplishing that.

Design and Manufacturing of Orthopedic and Assistive Devices

The main goal of *Design and Manufacturing of Orthopedic and Assistive Devices* is to provide you with state of the art knowledge and ways of thinking in the orthopedic and assistive device design field. With your obtained knowledge and skills you are able to help people in need for an assistive device to make people mobile again. Subjects that will be covered are: Design Techniques, Orthopedic devices (Orthesis, Prosthesis and Orthopedic shoes), State of the art Technology, Manufacturing skills, Modern Ways of Manufacturing, Evaluation techniques.

What can you expect from us?

A class size of both international and Dutch students (12 - 26 students). Your lecturers are experienced in their field of knowledge. The programs are designed to be interactive with many practical assignments.

What do we expect from you?

You are interested in the subject of the program, your English is sufficiently, you have an open mind, you want to work hard but also want to take part in the exciting social and cultural activities which show you the highlights of Eindhoven and the Netherlands.

The Netherlands/Eindhoven

The Netherlands is a country in western Europe with a multicultural population of approximately 17 million people. It has a rich history in international trade, education, art, literature, design and sciences. This tiny country is famous for the great Dutch Masters, painters like Rembrandt and Van Gogh. They transformed the world around them just like today's Masters: designers, concept developers, and futurists.



In 2011 the city of Eindhoven with 200.000 inhabitants was called the Intelligent Community of the Year 2011 by ICF (Intelligent Community Forum). With two big universities, and more then 30.000 students it's a lively city with a lot of places to enjoy student life.

Didactic methods

The Summer School programs have a study load of 3 ECTS (1 ECTS = 28 hours of study). Most lectures take place in classrooms in one of the Fontys campus buildings in Eindhoven. The atmosphere in a Dutch classroom is open. Relationships between students and teachers are informal. Questions and discussions in class are very much appreciated.
