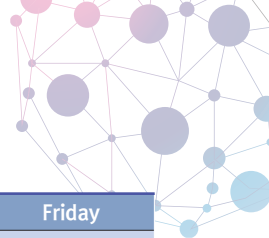

○ Application Requirements



- CNU Inbound Exchange Visiting Student Application
- Official Transcript
- Certificate of Enrollment
- One Recommendation Letter
- Bank Statement *(minimum of USD1,500)
- Passport Copy (in color)
- One Portrait Photo** (3.5cm x 4.5cm)

* Bank Statement is to certify that students can afford expenses while studying/staying in Korea. The minimum of the balance must be over USD1,500.
 ** Color photograph of face, front view, on white background, taken within the past six months
 ※ All the application documents must be approved and sent via the applicant's home university.

○ Visa (D-2-8 Student Visa)

Students need to hold a D-2-8 visa for the purpose of study even if student's home country is eligible for the visa exemption. Detailed instructions will be given after admission. Students are allowed to stay for 1 month (30 days) after arriving in Korea.
