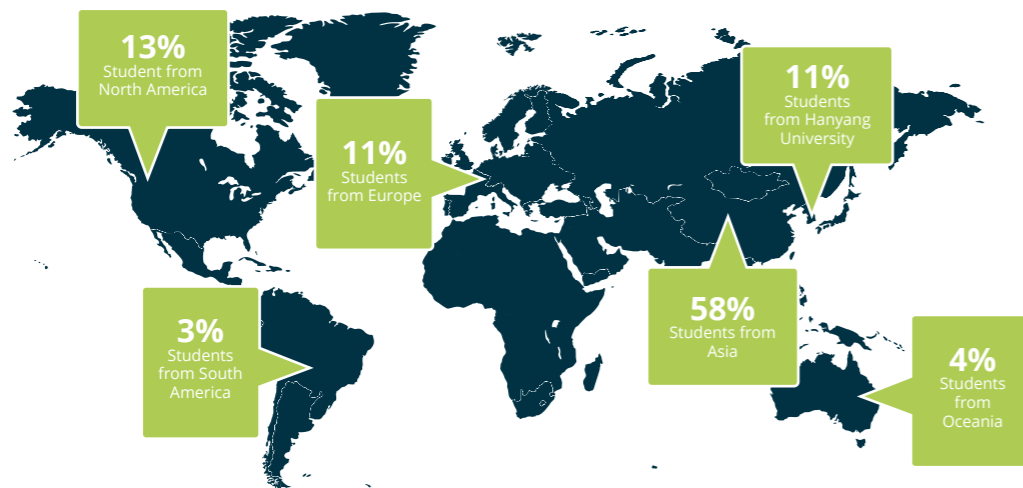
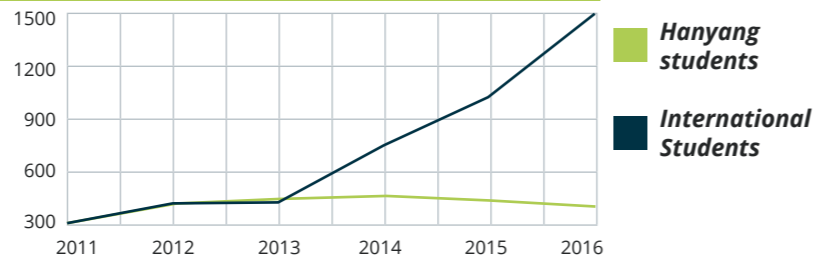

After completing the payment, students receive a student ID number needed for online course registration.
