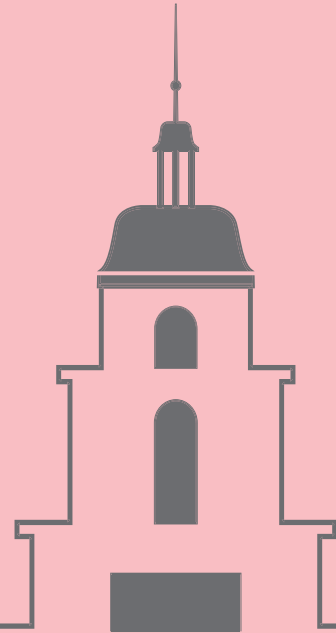


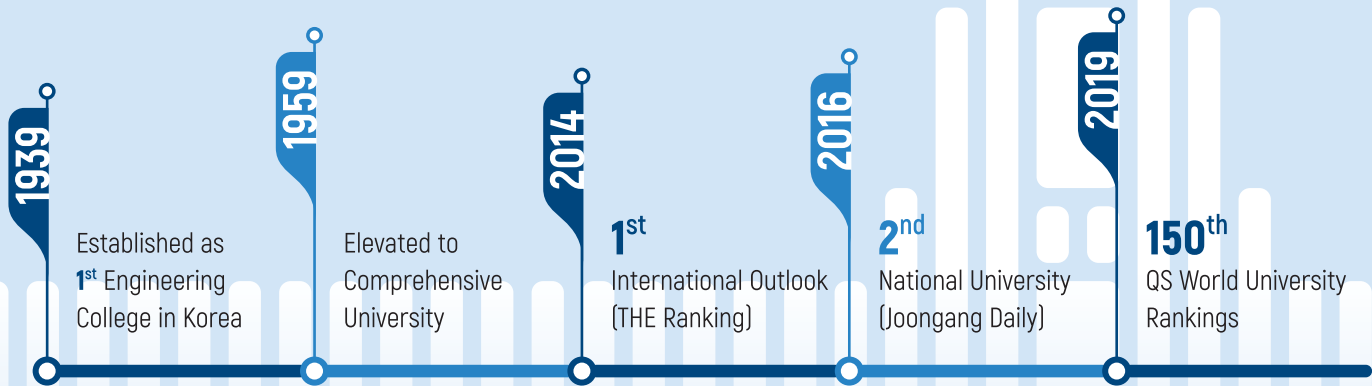

Hanyang University

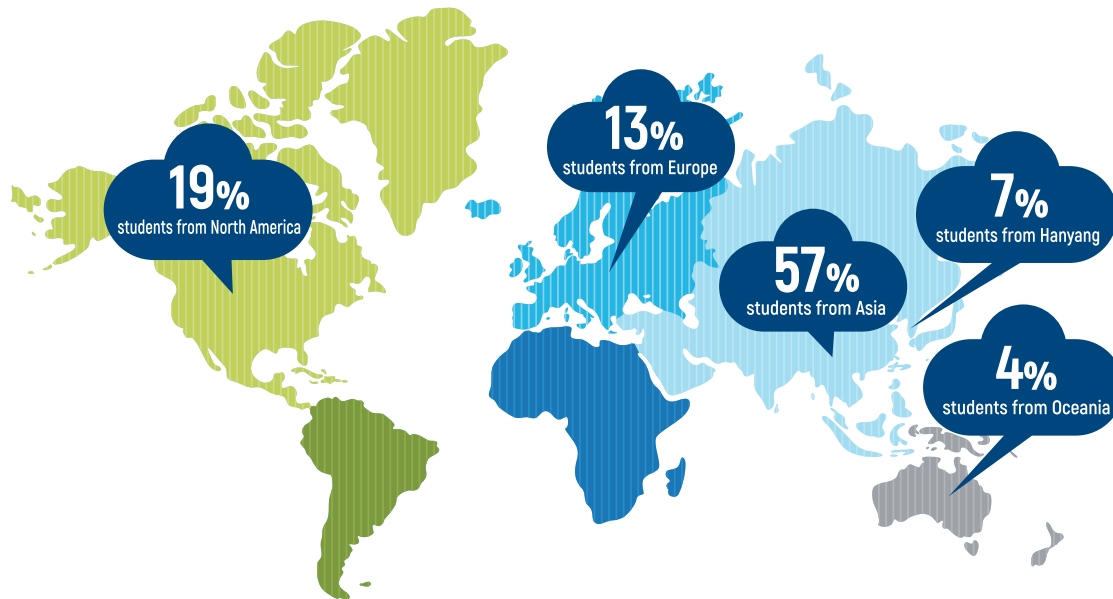
Hanyang University is the successor of DongA Polytechnic Institute, which was established in 1939 as the first engineering college in Korea. Today, Hanyang is home to more than 32,000 students in 24 colleges and 21 graduate schools. To continue its momentum of progress, Hanyang University has been striving to promote internationalization and consequently, every semester over 1,000 courses instructed in English are offered by about 200 foreign professors. 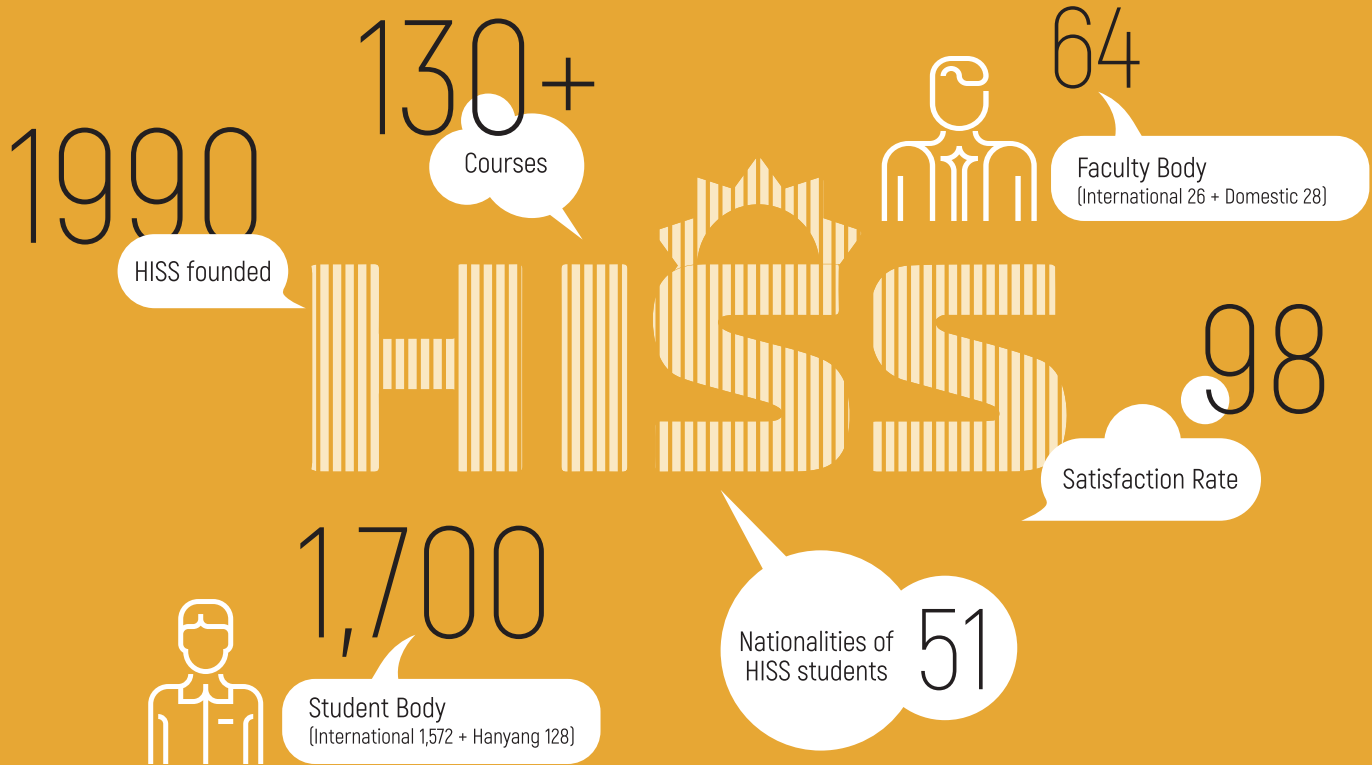
Welcome to **HISS 2020**

Online Application

Simple, efficient, all-online application process

Required: A copy of valid passport, Certified academic transcript.

January 15 - May 13 (Early Registration: by Feb. 29)

The application cannot proceed without the required documents

- Payment should be completed within 3 weeks after the application approval.

Scholarships

Non-Partner Univ.

- With the exception of the Early Registration, students are only eligible for one of the scholarships mentioned below.
- An additional document may be required to apply for scholarships.

Early Registration _____ KRW 200,000

Students who register before February 29th – the early registration deadline – are eligible for this scholarship.

Academic Excellence _____ KRW 500,000

Students whose cumulative home university's GPA is over 95% are eligible for this scholarship.

HISS/HIWS Alumni _____ KRW 500,000

Students who have enrolled in HISS/HIWS before are considered Hanyang Alumnus and are eligible for this scholarship.

Hanyang Family _____ KRW 500,000

Students whose parent is a HYU Alumnus or is a full-time faculty or staff member at HYU are eligible for this scholarship

Accommodation
